³ “Graduates employed in the field” means graduates who report that they are gainfully employed in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate obtaining the position.

⁴ Placement Rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
